Five Factors of Attraction That Will Make You Irresistible!

1. The Attraction of Priority – She Feels Significant

- a. **KEY THOUGHT:** It is God's plan for marriage that you make it your goal to elevate in every way the place your wife has in your life. She has to feel like she has no competitors – that she is #1.
- b. 1 Cor. 7:33,34 - ³² I would like you to be free from concern. An unmarried man is concerned about the Lord's affairs—how he can please the Lord. ³³ But a married man is concerned about the affairs of this world—**how he can please his wife**— ³⁴ and his interests are divided.

2. The Attraction of Safety – She Feels Protected

- a. **KEY THOUGHT:** God's plan is that you are faithful to her. She needs to feel safe with you through your kindness and consideration but also safe when you are away – that you are trustworthy with other women and on the internet.
- b. 1 Peter 3:7, Husbands, in the same way **be considerate as you live with your wives**, and **treat them with respect** as the weaker partner and as heirs with you of the gracious gift of life, so that nothing will hinder your prayers.
- c. Proverbs 20:6- Many claim to have unfailing love, but a **faithful person** who can find?

3. The Attraction of Value – She Feels Cherished

- a. **KEY THOUGHT:** View your wife as God's greatest gift to you. Treat her so well. She must feel valued through your extra efforts of care and romance. Cherish her and help her feel it!
- b. Proverbs 18:22-The man who finds a wife **finds a treasure**, and he receives favor from the LORD.
- c. Proverbs 31:10, 28, 29, 31- A wife of noble character who can find? She is **worth far more than rubies**. Her children arise and call her blessed; her husband also, and he praises her:
“Many women do noble things, but you surpass them all.” **Honor her** for all that her hands have done, and let her works bring her praise at the city gate.



4. The Attraction of Sacrifice – She Feels Honored

- a. **KEY THOUGHT:** As head of the home, you are there to SERVE. It is not a privilege but a responsibility that God holds you to – He wants your marriage and family life to go well. Sacrifice for your wife. Honor her by selflessly giving preference to her.
- b. Eph. 5:25-27- Husbands, **love your wives**, just as Christ loved the church and **gave himself up for her** ²⁶ to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word, ²⁷ and to present her to himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless.
- c. Mark 10:42-45- Jesus called them together and said, “You know that those who are regarded as rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their high officials exercise authority over them. ⁴³ Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become **great among you must be your servant**, ⁴⁴ and whoever wants to be first must be slave of all. ⁴⁵ For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, **but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.**”

5. The Attraction of Faith – She Feels Led

- a. **KEY THOUGHT:** God wants you to be a Godly man. Don't talk it without the walk. She needs to see that your faith transform you and your daily interaction with her and the kids. When Jesus makes that kind of difference, she'll respect that.
- b. Psalm 78:72- And David **shepherded them with integrity of heart**; with skillful hands he led them.
- c. Psalm 127:1-**Unless the LORD builds the house,** the builders labor in vain. Unless the LORD watches over the city, the guards stand watch in vain.
- d. Josh. 24:15- But if serving the LORD seems undesirable to you, then choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your ancestors served beyond the Euphrates, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you are living. **But as for me and my household, we will serve the LORD.**”
